Hi Everyone,

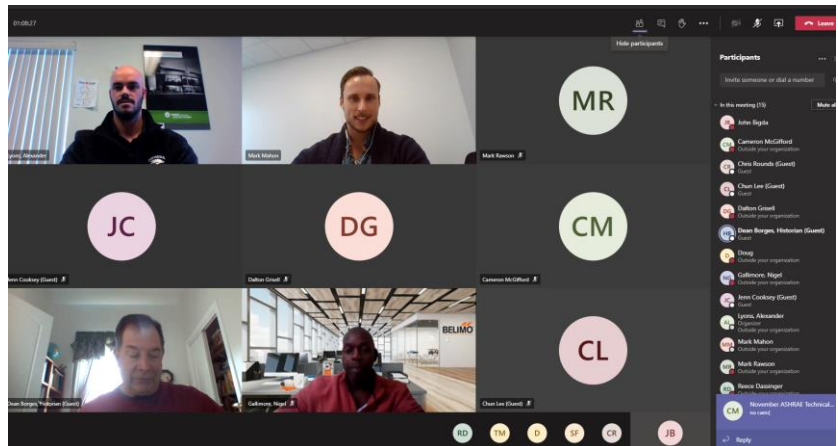
